**DECLARATION OF AGUSTIN CACCURI IN  
SUPPORT OF REQUEST FOR SERVICE  
AWARDS**

1 I, Agustin Caccuri, declare as follows.

2 1. I submit this declaration in support of Proposed Class Representative Plaintiff's Motion for  
3 Attorney's Fees, Expenses, and Service Awards. I have personal knowledge of the information set forth  
4 in this declaration and, if called to testify, could testify competently thereto.

5 2. I reside in Los Angeles, California.

6 3. I own a PlayStation 5 Digital Edition console. I have purchased digital video games on the  
7 PlayStation Store and downloaded games to my console during the Class Period. I envision purchasing  
8 and downloading more digital games from the PlayStation Store in the future.

9 4. I previously served as one of the three named plaintiffs in this litigation to help ensure  
10 accountability and promote fairness for consumers who purchased digital games on the PlayStation Store  
11 at supracompetitive prices. In so doing, I was subject to public scrutiny as my participation in this case  
12 became a matter of public record. Emblematic of this fact, my name remains first on the case caption and  
13 as such I will always be associated with this case. Moreover, news coverage regarding this litigation has  
14 singled me out by name. *See, e.g.* [https://www.courthousenews.com/gamers-near-7-million-settlement-](https://www.courthousenews.com/gamers-near-7-million-settlement-in-playstation-credits-with-sony/)  
15 [in-playstation-credits-with-sony/](https://www.courthousenews.com/gamers-near-7-million-settlement-in-playstation-credits-with-sony/) (stating "[o]netime lead plaintiff Agustin Caccuri purchased a  
16 PlayStation5 Digital Edition, which does not have a disc drive and can only play games purchased from a  
17 digital retailer.").

18 5. I consulted with Motley Rice LLC on the pre-filing investigation and development of the case.  
19 *Caccuri v. Sony Interactive Entertainment LLC et al.*, Case No. 3:21-cv-03361, ECF No. 1.

20 6. In fulfilling my responsibilities as a proposed lead plaintiff, I responded to broad and  
21 burdensome discovery. Together with Messrs. Cendejas and Neumark, I responded to 26 requests for  
22 production. The documents produced included: emails relating to Play Station receipts, advertisements,  
23 and communications. I coordinated with Class Counsel throughout this process to ensure that my  
24 productions were thorough, accurate, and responsive to the requests.

25 7. I personally prepared for and attended the early neutral evaluation in this case. In preparation  
26 for the early neutral evaluation, I participated in meetings with Plaintiffs' counsel and reviewed  
27 materials. Though the case did not progress to the point of my deposition, I was willing, ready, and  
28 preparing to sit for my deposition, which was in the process of being scheduled when the case settled.

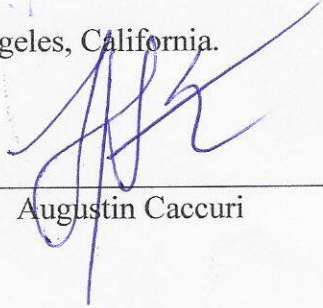
1 8. Throughout the litigation, I maintained regular communication and coordination with

3 developments, and responded promptly to inquiries and requests. I provided input when necessary and
